


### Administrator's Message- Jayna

Over the past 63 years, we helped 1452 Grandfriends either recover from an illness or injury and return to their home, or spend the last years of their life in the comfort of their new home Divine Providence. During this time, so many families have become a part of our family and we feel blessed that they shared their loved ones with us. Between 1998 and 2003, Eugenia Berdan was one of these Grandfriends. Like so many, the love and care given to Genie by the staff and Sisters resonated in the heart of her daughter, Colette (Berdan) Bednarczyk. Colette was so moved that upon her death, she asked that a lasting legacy gift be established to help continue the mission of Divine Providence.

To honor her wish, we were recently contacted by her family to establish the Colette M. (Berdan) Bednarczyk Endowment. This endowment is of a perpetual nature and only the income generated by it is to be distributed for use by Divine Providence. It is a restricted permanent endowment with the purpose of providing ongoing financial assistance.

Her immediate family has generously offered a 2 for 1 match with a goal of raising an initial \$150,000.00. If we can raise \$50,000 by February 1, 2024, the \$100,000.00 matching donation from the family will follow shortly thereafter. Endowed funds are permanent. Your gift will last forever – it keeps on giving—to benefit a designated operating expense. For example, distributed funds can be used to purchase minor equipment, wheelchairs, furniture, etc. Excluding the beds, most of our resident room furniture is about 30 years old.
