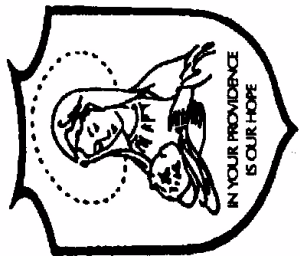

## A note from the Administrator- Jayna

Exciting news, our window replacement project is scheduled to begin installation on Monday September 8<sup>th</sup>. Renewal by Anderson windows for the Blue and Rose Hall in the nursing home along with the living room and mall area were ordered in April from Schmidt Siding and Window. During the installation, residents getting new windows in their room, will have to stay out of their room for around 2 hours, but our staff will make sure they are taken care of during this temporary displacement. The crew installing the windows are familiar with our home because they installed windows in 2017 down the Peach and Green halls, so they have a good plan based on past experience. Since our old Pella windows getting removed have blinds inside the window, immediately after replacement, our maintenance team will install new blinds for privacy.

Part of the mall area including the resident dining room and activity room already had new windows installed in 2020 by the same installers. Now the offices, beauty shop, snack shop, laundry, and maintenance shop will get their new windows. After completion, the nursing home should have all renovated windows. Now, we are in the process of getting updated quotes for windows in the Lake Villa Maria apartments, so that we can start planning for their replacement in small manageable projects.

Thanks to the awesome support from our families, friends, and community we are able to start this much needed window replacement project.

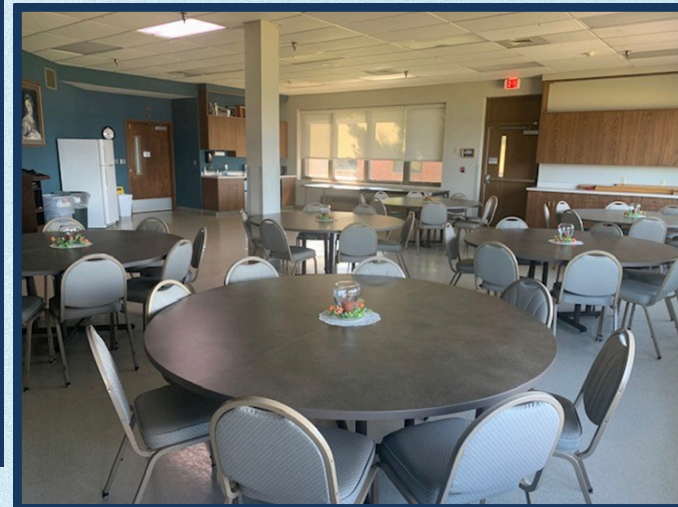
